

CN freight train derails in southeastern Michigan

Canadian National freight train derails in Macomb County, closing several major roads

CLINTON TOWNSHIP, Mich. (AP) -

A Canadian National freight train has derailed in southeastern Michigan, blocking traffic on several major roads.

WWJ-AM says the train derailed about 4 a.m. Sunday in Clinton Township, about 20 miles northeast of Detroit.

Police tell WXYZ-TV that a broken axle caused the crash and says no one was injured.

Canadian National Railway Co. officials say they expect to clear the derailment Sunday afternoon.
