## Derailment investigated

Canadian National Railway crews were cleaning up a train derailment in Thunder Bay, just north of the Central Avenue bridge, on Friday. Patrick Waldron, a CN spokesman, said four empty grain cars came off the tracks around 10:30 a.m. while being moved inside the rail yard. The empty cars remained upright and there was no spillage of grain. Waldron says no one was injured and yard operations continued around the mishap. A crane will place the cars back on the tracks and necessary repairs to the tracks will be made. An investigation into the cause of the derailment is underway.
